

Rules and Regulations

Grand Prize Package Description:

- Sleepover party for up to 20 children that includes:
 - Pizza and juice dinner
 - Private access to all of the Museum's exhibits

 - Late night movie screening
 - Doughnut and juice breakfast

Raffle Rules and Regulations:

- All proceeds from this raffle will benefit the Louisiana Children's Museum (LCM).
- Interested individuals or parties may purchase an unlimited amount of raffle entries at \$20 per entry. Each ticket will be numbered and raffle entries may be purchased at the Museum's Front Desk, the Museum Store, or online at www.lcm.org. Only Museum employees will be prohibited from participating in this raffle.
- Each filled-out raffle entry form will be placed in a raffle box. All entries purchased online will be filled onto raffle entry forms and entered into the raffle box in a timely manner.
- For each purchase of a raffle entry, the purchaser is entitled to two (2) Admit One Child Free with Paying Adult single day pass to the Museum.
- The Raffle Drawing will take place at the close of business on Saturday, July 31, 2010 at 4:30 p.m. A Museum employee will draw one ticket at random from the raffle box. Only one Grand Prize Package is available and will be rewarded to the first raffle entry form pulled.
- Raffle winners do not need to be present to win and will be notified via telephone and email of their reward. However, if the Grand Prize Package is not redeemed within one week, the first raffle pull will cease to be the winning ticket and a Museum employee will draw one more raffle pull from the original and undisturbed raffle box. This process will continue until the Grand Prize Package is redeemed. All entries in the raffle box will remain undisturbed until the Grand Prize Package is redeemed.
- Based on the requirements of the Louisiana Office of Charitable Gaming, Julia Bland, Simonne Robinson, Jake Yunker, Jennifer Brammell, Daphne Moore and Julia Widmann will serve as Members-in-Charge (MICs).
- Also based on the requirements of the Louisiana Office of Charitable Gaming, "Pursuant to the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute 4:701 et seq., and having met the requirements exempting them from normal licensing procedures, this exemption is hereby granted" through license number E0005024
